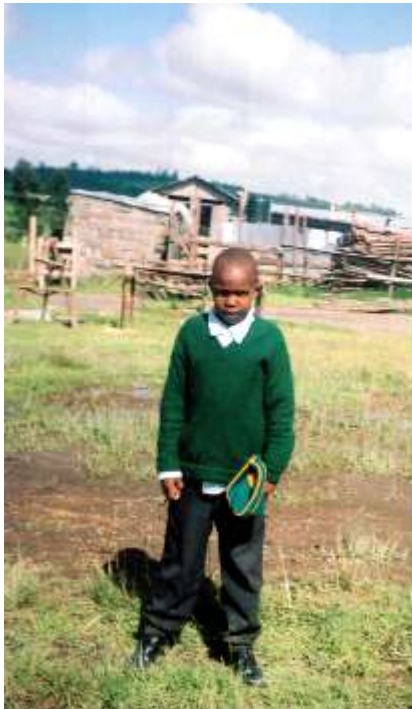


Called to Love

- They have a terminal illness like AID
- They cannot afford high school fees
- An unwanted pregnancy
