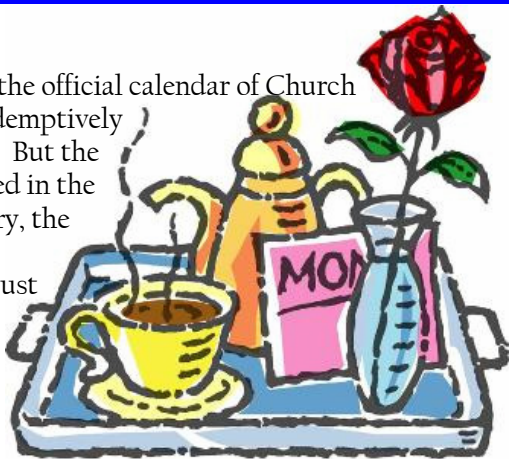




Happy mother's day
